Dear Residents and Family,

We currently have zero Independent Living residents, one Brewster Health Center resident, and nine staff testing positive for COVID-19. We continue to test residents and staff daily based on exposure and various symptoms. Family contact remains the primary driver of new cases among both residents and staff.

Positive cases are still very high in Shawnee County. Luckily the level of illness associated with this wave appears to be much less than prior ones -- at least for the vaccinated and those with immunity through prior infection. With that being said, Brewster is home to some of our community's most vulnerable and it is important we take reasonable steps to reduce the risk of viral transmission here on our campus.

At this time, masks are required to be worn by all residents, staff, and guests while in the common spaces of Brewster. Please visit the front desk of either Redwood or The Evergreens if you are in need of a KN95 mask.
