Dear Residents and Family,

We currently have two independent living residents testing positive for COVID-19. We have identified a number of other residents who have had exposure to positive cases through family or other community activities. We have identified 3 Health Center staff with COVID-19 over the last week.

As we live through this wave of the virus it is imperative that we monitor ourselves for symptoms of illness. COVID-19 is easily mistaken for general muscle soreness, fatigue or other cold and allergy symptoms and spreads easily and quickly once a person is symptomatic.

**PLEASE STAY HOME if you feel any signs or symptoms of illness even if small!** It is far better to stay home one day, and learn it's allergies than to spread the virus to several others. Give our Community Nursing team a call if you have symptoms 274-3342 and wish to speak with a nurse.

We continue to ask everyone to wear a mask when in common spaces, and to practice social distancing when practical. The dining, activities, and other programs will continue in a normal fashion.
